He was shot down over Koblenz, Germany and returned to the USA, to San Antonio, in May 1945.

Jim was married to Billie Louise Dixon for 60 years until her death. He worked at General Dynamics for years. When he retired, he was a logistics specialist in Technical Publications.

Jim was lucky to have a second love in his life. He married Dolores "Dee" Olsen on May 5, 2007. They loved each other dearly for 13 years. They enjoyed traveling and living in the Hill Country of Texas.
